

Directions to Bourne Abbey

From the South:

Take the A15 (Peterborough-Lincoln road.) When you arrive at the southern end of the Bourne, carry straight over the roundabout heading towards the town centre. After almost a mile, there is an 'S' bend, after which the Memorial Gardens are on the left. Opposite the Memorial Gardens is a lane on the right with signing to the 'Abbey Church.' About 80 yards along the lane is Church Walk. Turn right for parking along the Walk, or park in the Church Hall car park to your left.

From the North:

Take the A15 (Lincoln-Peterborough road.) When you arrive at the northern end of Bourne, continue for almost a mile until you come to a large junction with 4-way traffic lights. Continue over the junction on the A15. About 200 yards on the left is a lane, with signing to the 'Abbey Church.' Roughly 80 yards along the lane is Church Walk. Turn right for parking along the Walk, or park in the Church Hall car park to your left.

From the East:

From Spalding, take the A151 about 11 miles until you come to Bourne. Continue on this road until you come to a large junction with 4-way traffic lights. Turn left onto the A15, sign-posted to Peterborough. About 200 yards on the left is a lane, with signing to the 'Abbey Church.' Roughly 80 yards along the lane is Church Walk. Turn right for parking along the Walk, or park in the Church Hall car park to your left.

From the West:

From Stamford, take the A6121 for about 10 miles. Just outside Bourne is a 'T' junction. Turn right onto the A151. After about 400 yards is a roundabout. Carry straight on. After about a mile you will come to a large junction with 4-way traffic lights. Turn right onto the A15 for Peterborough. About 200 yards on the left is a lane, with signing to the 'Abbey Church.' Roughly 80 yards along the lane is Church Walk. Turn right for parking along the walk, or park in the Church Hall car park to your left.

(If you are travelling from the A1, take the Colsterworth junction, following signs for Bourne on the A151. After about 12 miles you will arrive at a roundabout. Carry straight on for another mile or so, when you will arrive at the main junction. (Now follow directions, as above.)
